Information:

To be eligible for OQHA year-end awards exhibitors and owners must be members. A horse must compete in a given class in at least 60% (16 judges for open & Amateur, 11 judges for youth) of the OQHA approved shows within the State of Oregon and earn a minimum of twelve (12) year-end points to be eligible for a year-end award. For youth: weekend (Saturday & Sunday) points and judges count for year-end awards and State Qualifying –week day (Thursday & Friday) count for National Points only. To be eligible for OQHA Oregon Bred awards, the horse must be registered with OQHA as Oregon Bred.

NEW AQHA rules:

408(b) Amateur Division approval: “management WILL combine these classes back into an all-age when there are less than 3 entries in amateur or select classes.

Allow a horse with any performance register of merit to be eligible to compete in all divisions of performance halter.

All Around & Reserve Awards for the 4-day circuit: Open, Novice Amateur, Amateur, Select, Novice Youth 14-18 & 13 & Under, Youth 18 & Under. **Must show in 3 AQHA categories to win All Around Award. All Around awards will be determined as per AQHA rule 417. High Point award for Small Fry division.

This show is governed by the 2010 AQHA Handbook. Registration papers & membership cards will be checked.

Any owner or exhibitor whose personal check (for show fees or stalls) fails to clear the bank, has 30 days to make the check good. If he or she fails to do so, points for that show will not count for year-end awards and could be subject to AQHA notification. There is a \$25.00 fee for each NSF check.
