Any novice exhibitor that enters a novice class may enter the corresponding amateur or youth class for half price.
Example: Novice enters novice amateur showmanship, they can enter amateur showmanship for \$7.50.

AQHA permits may be used for novices to show non owned horses. Horse showing on a permit are not eligible for NCQHA year-end awards. **To be eligible for NCQHA year end awards, exhibitors, handlers and owners must be members.**

To ensure a fresh cow for all cattle classes, make your reservations using the form provided.

Cutting Entries: Close May 1, 2008. Post entries are not guaranteed fresh cattle. There are no post entry penalties in other cattle classes.

Rules:

This show is governed by the 2008 AQHA Handbook. Registration papers and AQHA cards will be checked.

Any owner or exhibitor whose personal check (for show fees or stalls) fails to clear the bank, has 30 days to make the check good. If he or she fails to do so, points for that show will not count for year-end awards and could be subject to AQHA notification. There is a \$25.00 fee for each NSF check.

You have 30 days from the last day of the show to dispute any charges. After 30 days, all charges and fees are final.

If you have tack changes or class conflicts, please inform the office and the back gate at least 2 classes ahead of the time. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be on time for classes. We don't want anyone to miss their classes and will work to help resolve any conflicts.

No horses allowed on the black top by the pavillion. All dogs must be leashed and under the control of a responsible person. Dogs not on leashes will incur a \$50.00 penalty from the fairgrounds.

Stalls:

All stalls must be prepaid and are assigned on a first paid basis. Reservations must be made by May 1, 2008. **There will be no refunds on stalls.** If you reserve a stall and are a no show, you will be billed for the stall. By order of the Fire Marshall, there will be no parking between the barns, so you will need to reserve a tack room. No arrivals prior to 9 am on Thursday. Arenas open at noon on Thursday. Only shavings are allowed on the fairgrounds and should be pre-ordered or you may bring your own.

Shavings:

NCQHA does NOT provide shavings. You must pre-order from Reynolds Ranch Farm Supply. 530-527-1622 or cell 530-945-8237. Payment is made to Reynolds Ranch. They will be on site Thursday, Friday and Saturday from noon to 6 pm. You must pre-order from the store if you plan to arrive after 6 pm on Thursday or if you want bedding, etc delivered to your stalls before you arrive. Hay and grain will be delivered by request. Store hours: Monday – Friday 8 am to 6 pm Saturday, 8 am to 5 pm & Sunday 10 am to 4 pm.

CHAMPIONS: Open, Youth, Amateur, Novice Youth, Novice Amateur

Champion buckle and reserve Big D sheets awarded for all AQHA categories and small fry division.

Exhibitors showing for saddles must show halter 5 times. To be eligible for year-end awards, a horse must be shown at 5 out of the 6 shows. The NCQHA approved show dates are as follows: Red Bluff, February 22-24, 2008 & May 9-11, 2008: Eugene, OR April 4-6, 2008. The April 4-6, 2008 show in Oregon is not mandatory but points will count for year-end awards.

Big D blanket, hood and silver spurs, courtesy Glen Drake and Caliente Saddle Shop. Highest combined scores for cowhorse and reining. Halter is not required. Must show 5 of 6 shows.

****NCQHA roping futurity (heading and heeling):** Open to any breed ages 5 and under. The futurity will have 2 go rounds. The entry fee will be \$300.00 per division with a \$30.00 cattle charge per horse. All of the entry fee will be jackpotted back. A saddle will be awarded to the high point futurity rope horse (heading and heeling points combined). An additional saddle will also be awarded at the Oregon Summer Classic for high point futurity rope horse (heading and heeling points combined). This saddle will be awarded by combining points from the NCQHA futurity and the Oregon Summer Classic Futurity.

CASH AWARD: \$500.00

A \$500.00 cash award will be awarded to the overall high point horse for the weekend (youth, amateur, open). The points will be an accumulation of the weekend points. Horse must be shown in halter all three days. Owners and exhibitors must be members of NCQHA.
